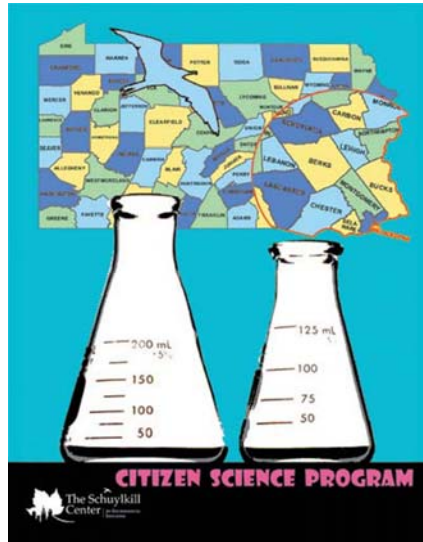




## Citizen Science Program Returns!
