



Wildlife Clinic Internship Program

The Wildlife Clinic at the Schuylkill Center is seeking engaged and committed interns for the Spring/Summer 2022 season. Throughout the 6-week program, interns will become skilled caretakers of many injured and orphaned young wild animals. Interns will learn all the basics of wildlife husbandry as well as essential wildlife rehabilitation skills.

This is an unpaid position with the potential for college credit. You must be able to commit to 20 hours per week for a full 6-week period with no interruptions. After the completion of 120 hours, you may continue as an animal care volunteer.

This internship program is designed for all levels of experience. Our team is happy to work with individual applicants to help meet their personal and professional goals. Novices seeking an introduction to the basics of wildlife care and graduate students pursuing intensive hands-on training are encouraged to apply.

Duties include:

- Feed, weigh, monitor, medicate, and assess animals for release
- Daily upkeep of the care room
- Help direct animal care volunteers
- Assist with training new interns and volunteers towards the end of your internship
